Adult asthma and COPD 2021 Organisational Audit Report: Erratum

UPDATE August 2022

Version 2 of the NACAP Adult asthma and COPD 2021 organisational audit summary report and benchmarked key indicator report were published on 12 August 2022 (following the Version 1 publication date of 16 June 2022). Version 2 corrects hospital level performance for four hospitals on the key performance indicator: *Hold a weekly multidisciplinary team (MDT) meeting between hospital and community for people with COPD (Improvement priority)* and makes the associated adjustment to the aggregate national figure and related aspects of the report. This is required in order to factor in where free text responses, rather than categorical data, provided evidence that the KPI was met. Updates were made in the following sections of the two audit reports:

Summary report:

- > Page 3, infographic *Summary of performance against KPIs*, and paragraph 1: Percentage of hospitals in England and Wales meeting KPI on multidisciplinary team meetings updated to 35.2%.
- > Page 7, paragraph 4: Percentage of hospitals in England and Wales meeting KPI on multidisciplinary team meetings updated to 35.2%.

Benchmarked key indicator report:

- > Aggregated national data against KPI *Hold a weekly multidisciplinary team (MDT) meeting between hospital and community for people with COPD (Improvement priority)* updated as follows:
 - **All:** numerator: 56
 - **All:** percentage: 35.2%
 - **England:** numerator: 51
 - **England:** percentage: 34.9%
- > Hospital level data: Result for KPI (columns P-R) *Hold a weekly multidisciplinary team (MDT) meeting between hospital and community for people with COPD (Improvement priority)* updated to 'KPI met' for the following hospitals:
 - Maidstone General Hospital (Row 130)
 - Peterborough City Hospital (Row 13)
 - Tunbridge Wells Hospital (Row 131)
 - Watford General Hospital (Row 15)
